

7. The sentences below form a story of how a cocoa bean is made into a chocolate bar. Please put the story in the right order.


- a) Then they dry the beans in the hot sun

- Your whole school learns about Fairtrade
- Your school promotes and takes action for Fairtrade in school and the wider community

Other correct answers might include: buy Fairtrade, telling your friends about Fairtrade, holding a Fairtrade assembly etc.
